

Execu/Tech Software License Agreement

Use of Execu/Tech software acknowledges full acceptance of this agreement.

1. Execu/Tech Systems, Inc., (Licensor), hereby grants to Licensee a license to use Licensor's computer software programs and documents (the System) within the limits and conditions set forth in this agreement, which provides as follows:
2. The System is protected by copyright and/or other intellectual property laws and any unauthorized use of the System may violate such laws. Except as expressly provided herein, Execu/Tech and its suppliers do not grant any express or implied right to you under any patents, copyrights, trademarks, or trade secret information with respect to the System.
3. Licensee understands and agrees that he is being granted a license to use the System exclusively on only one computer hardware system with multiple computers networked together. A hardware system is defined as a single computer or a network of computers sharing one copy of the System's data files. Annually a new code will be issued to renew this license. There is no additional charge for this code.
4. Licensee agrees that such license does not include the right to reproduce, publish, or license any part of the System.
5. Licensee believes the System is accurate and reliable and Licensor is responsible for correcting any program errors in the original System for a period of one (1) year from the delivery of the System.
6. Except as provided herein, there are no other warranties expressed or implied, including any warranties providing for the fitness of the System for any particular purpose.
7. In no event shall Licensor be liable for any consequential, incidental, indirect, or special damages of any kind upon the breach of any obligation contained in this agreement.
8. Under no circumstances shall Licensor's liability exceed the total price paid to Licensor for the System.
9. Licensee shall not solicit or use the services of any employee or representative of Licensor without prior written approval of Licensor.
10. Licensor is held harmless for any problems that arise because of hardware and/or software that is not sold or licensed by Licensor.
11. Non-payment of invoices, presented by Licensor to Licensee, voids this license agreement and the Licensee is prohibited from using the System. The Licensor is hereby given permission to use whatever means necessary to insure the System is non-operational.
12. This License Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, United States of America, without regard to conflict of law principles. All suits, proceedings or claims in connection with these Terms of Use shall be brought in the state or federal courts of the State of Florida in the county of Bay and you hereby consent to the jurisdiction and venue of those courts.
